This communication is to inform you of the following upcoming activities for the 2022–2023 Texas Assessment Program.

CALENDAR OF EVENTS

The [Calendar of Events](#) for the 2022–2023 school year is now posted on the Texas Assessment website. This preliminary version of the calendar includes pre-administration events and administration events. Descriptions and dates for reporting events will be included in an updated version to be posted in early fall 2022. Printed versions of the updated Calendar of Events with reporting information will be shipped to districts later this fall.

USER ROLE PERMISSIONS

The [User Role Permissions](#) for the Texas Assessment Program have been updated for the 2022–2023 school year. Updates include new roles for the Texas Formative Assessment Resource (TFAR), new access for users to view Family Portal access codes, and more direct edit access for users who can add students.

SYSTEM UPDATES

- TIDE User Role Updates
Starting the week of August 8, district superintendent and district testing coordinator roles in the Test Information Distribution Engine (TIDE) will be updated to match those listed in AskTED. If a user is a district coordinator in TIDE but is not listed as the district coordinator in AskTED, that user's role will be converted to a district testing assistant.
- Cambium System Updates
As a reminder, TIDE, the Test Delivery System (TDS), and the Centralized Reporting System (CRS) will be offline between August 15 and 21, 2022, to complete a system rollover for the 2022–2023 school year. Please be sure to download any data files prior to **August 14, 2022**. All systems will be back online on Monday, August 22, 2022.

Although TDS will be unavailable for users to log in, practice tests will be accessible in guest mode.
