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To the Superintendent, Education Service Center Director, and Region and District Testing Coordinator Addressed:

This communication is to inform you of the availability of preliminary reports for the December 2022 State of Texas Assessments of Academic Readiness (STAAR<sup>®</sup>) end-of-course (EOC) assessments. The results included in the preliminary reports will be the same results included in the final reports for accountability unless changes are made during the data correction window.

### **STANDARD AND ADDITIONAL REPORTS FOR DISTRICTS**

Your district's preliminary December 2022 STAAR reports for accountability are posted in the district testing coordinator's inbox in the Test Information Distribution Engine (TIDE). These preliminary assessment reports include student report cards, confidential campus rosters, district and campus summary reports, and data files. Reports posted in the secure inbox will be available for 90 days.

For the December 2022 STAAR administration, item level data (items and images of responses) will not be included in the student data files posted. As a result, Student Data Requests (SDR) for this administration will not include item level data.

Printed copies of the Confidential Student Labels are being shipped to your district and are scheduled to arrive **January 30–February 1** unless your district opted out of receiving the labels. The shipments include additional orders placed by December 30, 2022.

Preliminary December 2022 STAAR results for accountability will be posted to the Analytic and Family Portals by **January 24**. Secure access to the Family Portal is available for parents and guardians from the [Texas Assessment](#) homepage by entering the student access code. For the December 2022 STAAR administration, the Family Portal will display student results only; item level data will not be available.

### **REGION REPORTS**

Preliminary December 2022 STAAR region reports and student-level data files are posted in the region testing coordinator's secure inbox in TIDE. Reports posted in the secure inbox will be available for 90 days.

### **DATA CORRECTIONS**

The data correction window for the December 2022 STAAR administration is **January 19–26, 2023**. Districts must resolve student information and test discrepancies and may submit score code changes and rescore requests for the December administration during this window. Changes submitted during this window will be reflected in the final assessment reports for accountability that will be provided on March 13. Any updates made after the data correction window will be included in scheduled updates but will not be reflected in reports used for accountability.

- Resolve student information discrepancies—district testing personnel should update the spelling of a student’s name, the student’s date of birth, and the student’s gender through the *View/Edit/Export Student*, *Upload Student Information*, or *Upload Additional Student Fields* module in TIDE. If a student is not reported in the correct district or campus, the district coordinator should contact [Texas Testing Support](#) to update the information.
- Resolve test discrepancies—district testing personnel should resolve test discrepancies from the *Discrepancy Resolution* module under *Data Cleanup* in TIDE.
- Submit score code changes—district testing personnel may submit a score code change by selecting the “Change Score Code” option under *Request Type* in the *Appeals/Score Codes* module in TIDE.
- Request rescoring—district testing personnel may request a rescore of the STAAR English I or English II essay. To request a rescore, district coordinators should select the “Re-Score a Test” option under *Request Type* in the *Appeals/Score Codes* module in TIDE. A purchase order must be included for the rescore to be processed. A rescore request that does not result in a positive score change will incur a charge of \$50.00.
