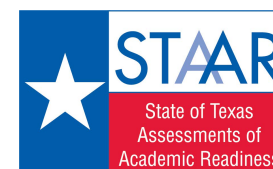

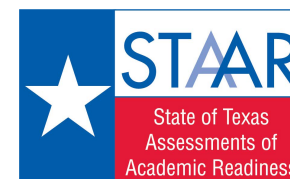

<i>Passages or Selections</i>	The <b>reading</b> section of the base test includes: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Two single reading passages</li> <li>• <u>And</u> a paired reading passage (two passages that are read together)</li> </ul>	The <b>writing</b> section of the base test includes: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Two revising selections</li> <li>• <u>And</u> two editing selections</li> <li>• <u>And</u> one extended constructed response (essay)</li> </ul>	<b>Field test</b> items include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <u>Either</u> a single reading passage</li> <li>• <u>Or</u> a paired reading passage</li> <li>• <u>Or</u> a single revising selection</li> <li>• <u>Or</u> two short editing selections</li> </ul>
